Memorial Day Parade – May 27th, 2024

The Huntley Memorial Day parade is to honor and to remember our fallen comrades.

Please read and sign below:

The parade is not intended as a political spectacle. There will be no campaigning and you will be allowed one sign to display. This is a means to show respect for those who gave all.

Correct decorum must be maintained at all times. Our parade is not a celebration it is somber way of thanking those who made the supreme sacrifice. Under no circumstances will foul language be tolerated.

Parade Line Up: In the parade there are no assigned places or favoritism of one group over another. As you arrive at staging the first vehicle is #1, as the others arrive you will fall in line behind each other. Please remember why we are having a parade. Any changes to the lineup are at the discretion of the Legion.

The Memorial Day Parade will kick-off from the Municipal Complex (10987 Main Street) at 11:00 a.m. All parade participants should assemble at the Municipal Complex parking lot beginning at 10:30 a.m. Parade marshals will be there to assist you in finding your spot in the line up.

Parade Route: The parade travels west on Main Street to Woodstock Street, turn right to go north and disperse from there on 1st or 2nd Street.

At the conclusion of the parade, there will be speakers and a presentation honoring those that paid the ultimate sacrifice for our freedoms.

Please Note: Candy may not be thrown during the parade but may be handed out (per Police Order).

In consideration for the acceptance of our parade registration and with the understanding that our participation in this event is only on condition that I/we enter into this agreement, I/we hereby assume the inherent and extraordinary risks involved in participating in the Huntley Memorial Day Parade and any risk inherent in any other activities connected with this event in which I/we may voluntarily participate.
