On Wednesday January 26, 2011 the Huntley Police Department filed charges in a stolen vehicle case.

Officers from the department were called to the 10800 block of Harry Dr. to take a report of a stolen vehicle. The owner of the vehicle stated that a person known to her had stolen her 2009 Chevrolet Malibu along with a pack of cigarettes and money totaling less than \$150.00. The victim stated to officers that at approximately 5:00pm she had driven to the residence on Harry Dr. Huntley IL with the suspect whom which she had known prior to the incident. When the owner was distracted in the residence it is alleged that Hansen then took the victim's car along with the money and cigarettes.

Officers were advised by the owner that the car was in fact equipped with the On-Star service. Officers then contacted On-Star and they began tracking the vehicle's location. The vehicle was located by officers from the Oak Park Police Department at approximately 6:00pm in the 400 block of Garfield Rd in Oak Park IL. Hansen was taken into custody by the Oak Park Police Department without incident.

Hansen was transported to the Huntley Police Department where she was charged with the following:

1. 625ILCS 5/4-103a1 Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle (Class 2 Felony)
2. 720ILCS 5/16-1a Theft (Class 3 Felony)

Ms Hansen was transported to McHenry County Corrections to await bond call.
