Criminal Trespass To Residence

Date/Time of Incident: June 26, 2010 at 1:57 am

Location of Incident: 10700 Block of Alleghany Pass

Synopsis of Incident.

In the early morning hours of Saturday June 26, 2010 a criminal trespass to residence occurred in the 10700 block of Alleghany Pass. The female homeowner that was asleep in an upstairs bedroom was awakened by a suspect standing in her bedroom. The suspect then fled from the second floor bedroom downstairs through an unlocked rear patio door. The suspect ran past the male homeowner who was sleeping on a sofa near the patio door. The male woke up when he heard the suspect running down the stairs. He described the suspect as between 5'9 and 5'11 wearing a blue and green hooded sweatshirt with horizontal stripes. The suspects face was covered by the hood so the witness was not able to determine if the suspect was male or female. No other description is available at this time.

The suspect is believed to have entered the residence through an unlocked rear patio door. No items were taken and nobody was injured during the incident. This case is currently under investigation.
