Man arrested after robbing bank and crashing car

Christopher James Olsen is in police custody after he allegedly robbed the Harris Bank in Huntley.

At approximately 11:00am on Saturday November 27, 2010 Olsen is alleged to have entered the Harris Bank located at 12920 Route 47 in Huntley. He approached a bank teller carrying a shotgun and demanded money. After receiving an undisclosed amount of cash he fled the bank in a white Ford Tempo.

A description of the suspect and his vehicle was given to Huntley officers who began a search of the area. A short time after the robbery Huntley officers located the suspect driving a white Ford Tempo in the area of Route 47 and Powers Rd. The officers attempted to stop the suspect who then fled from the area in a white Ford Tempo. Officers pursued Olsen from Powers Rd to Big Timer Rd. into the City of Elgin. Huntley officers were then assisted by officers from the Elgin Police Department. The pursuit continued onto Route 31 in Elgin. Olsen then traveled to the intersection of South St. and Crystal St. where he drove his vehicle over the curb damaging the vehicle. The vehicle came to rest at the bottom of a grassy hill where he exited the vehicle and attempted to flee on foot. Olsen was apprehended and taken into custody.

After being taken into custody Olsen was transported to the Huntley Police Department where he is currently being held pending charges.

Special Agents from the FBI are also assisting with this case.
