Electronics Recycling The Village will be accepting your unwanted electronics at the Municipal Complex parking lot from **9am to Noon (or until dumpsters are full whichever is first)** Huntley Residents only - IDs will be checked. *Due to the popularity of this free event - expect long lines.*

- ◆ **Due to Space Limitations: only 1 TV or 1 Computer Monitor will be accepted per vehicle. See reverse side for other accepted items.**
- ◆ **Paper/Document Destruction** AMS Store and Shred will be accepting documents for destruction from **9am to Noon** at the Municipal Complex parking lot. Participants will receive a certificate of destruction for materials taken to be destroyed. Huntley Residents Only—IDs will be checked.
- ◆ **Spring Cleaning Drop Off** — clean out your basement/garage and drop off items (see item details on reverse side) at the dumpsters located at Public Works on East Main Street & Donald Drive from **9am to Noon**. Volunteers will be available to assist unload your vehicle. Huntley Residents Only - IDs will be checked.
- ◆ **Gently-Used Book Drive** - from **9am to Noon** bring your gently used books to be donated to non-profit organizations.
- ◆ **Take a tour of the West Wastewater Treatment Plant** West Main Street, between **9am—1pm** (tours take approximately 1 hour—last tour begins at Noon).
- ◆ **Free Mulch Pickup!** Come to Public Works on Donald Drive from **9am to Noon** and pickup free mulch for your yard. Huntley Residents Only—IDs will be checked.
- ◆ **Culvers Kids Arbor Day Coloring Contest** — kids be sure to pick up a coloring sheet at Culvers, Huntley Village Hall, Huntley Library or Huntley Park District from April 10th - 22nd and bring your best coloring work back to Culvers of Huntley between April 20th & 24th to get a free scoop! - Yard waste/grass clippings/branches, etc.
- Liquid waste (basically any liquids)
- Motor Oil
- Electronics (see reverse side for drop off location and time)
- White Goods (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, stoves, ovens, etc.) - to discard White Goods, contact your waste hauler and set up a special pick-up.
- Medical Waste (medication may be dropped off during regular business hours M-F at the Police Station)
- Hazardous Waste
- Batteries (all kinds)
- Tires
