Consideration of an Ordinance Amending the Village of Huntley Liquor Control Ordinance Section 110.24 – Limitation on Licenses, repealing one Class “D” liquor license

Introduction

The Village received notification that Wisted’s Supermarket will no longer be operating at 10442 Route 47. Wisted’s held a Class “D” liquor license.

Staff Analysis

The Liquor Commission is requested to amend the Village of Huntley Liquor Code of Ordinances to reduce the number of available Class “D” liquor licenses appropriately. Currently; there are eight (8) Class “D” liquor license holders:

1. Aldi
2. Armanetti’s
3. Huntley Food and Liquor
4. Jewel
5. Walgreens / Princeton Drive
6. Walgreens / Reed Road
7. Walmart
8. Wisted’s Supermarket

The amendment is being requested to reduce the number of Class “D” licenses from eight (8) to seven (7). The Village should not have any vacant liquor licenses available. As qualified applicants request a liquor license, licenses then can be added as needed.

The Class “D” license permits the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in sealed packages but not for consumption on the premises where sold.

**AN AMENDMENT TO THE VILLAGE OF HUNTLEY LIQUOR
CONTROL ORDINANCE SECTION 110.24 – LIMITATION ON LICENSES
REPEALING ONE CLASS “D” LICENSE**

Ordinance (O)2015-04.____

WHEREAS, the Village of Huntley regulates the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Village through its Liquor Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said Liquor Control Ordinance provides for the issuance of certain classes of liquor licenses and establishes the number of licenses available in each class; and

WHEREAS, Wisted’s Supermarket will no longer be operating at 10442 Route 47 and has surrendered their Class “D” liquor license; and

WHEREAS, the available Class “D” liquor licenses will be reduced from eight (8) to seven (7).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HUNTLEY as follows:

SECTION I: Section 110.24(A) of the Village of Huntley Liquor Control Ordinance is amended to reduce the number of Class “D” liquor licenses from eight to seven.

SECTION II: All other provisions of the Village of Huntley Liquor Control Ordinance not otherwise in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION IV: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
