**Introduction**

At the July 23, 2015 Liquor Commission hearing, Ordinance (O)2015-07.26 was approved issuing a Class “E” liquor license to the Huntley Park Foundation for the Huntley Fall Fest.

**Staff Analysis**

In follow up after the July 23<sup>rd</sup> hearing it was indicated by the Huntley Park Foundation / Fall Fest Committee that they wished to sell Cayman Jack Margaritas in addition to the beer, wine, Mike’s Hard Lemonade and Mai Tais previously approved at the July hearing. Since the margaritas were not included on the original application an amendment is necessary to allow for the sale of additional alcohol. A new application has been received and reviewed by the Village Clerk.

**Legal Analysis**

The Village Attorney has reviewed the amendment and all is in order for consideration at this time.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE (O)2015-07.26 AUTHORIZING  
THE ISSUANCE OF A CLASS “E” LIQUOR LICENSE  
IN THE VILLAGE OF HUNTLEY – HUNTLEY PARK FOUNDATION**

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commission is being presented with a request from the Huntley Park Foundation (Foundation) to amend Ordinance(O)2015-07.26 which authorized the issuance of a Class “E” liquor license for the 2015 Huntley Fall Fest; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation is requesting to sell Cayman Jack Margaritas in addition to the beer, wine, Mike’s Hard Lemonade and Bob Chinn’s Mai Tais previously approved by Ordinance (O)2015-07.26; and

WHEREAS, new application pages have been submitted as well as approval from the Huntley Park Foundation to include Cayman Jack Margaritas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE LIQUOR COMMISSION of the Village of Huntley as follows:

SECTION I: Ordinance (O)2015-07.26 as issued to the Huntley Park Foundation for the 2015 Huntley Fall Fest taking place on Huntley Park District Property is hereby amended to include the sale of Cayman Jack Margaritas subject to the following conditions:

1. Petitioner must show proof of the State of Illinois Liquor License before the Village of Huntley Class “E” Liquor License becomes effective.
2. The beer, wine, Mike’s Hard Lemonades, Bob Chinn’s Mai Tais coolers and Cayman Jack Margaritas can only be sold and consumed in the designated beer garden area.

SECTION II: It is the consensus of the Liquor Commission to waive the fee.

SECTION III: All other provisions of the Liquor Control Ordinances of the Village of Huntley shall remain in full force and effect, including, but not limited to, the obligation of all individuals serving alcohol to be BASSET trained.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its date of passage.
