



50/50 Residential Tree Replacement Program

UPDATED: September 25, 2009

The option to order a tree through the 50/50 Program, for planting this fall, is no longer available as trees are already ordered and will be planted from September 28th – October 9th

Tree orders are still being accepted for planting next spring; so if you've received information regarding the 2009 50/50 program but have not placed your order yet you may still do so.

Please note: the Bradford Pear tree is sold out and no longer available.

ASH TREE/EMERALD ASH BORER INFORMATION: All Ash trees on residential parkways within the Village which have shown signs of infestation by the Emerald Ash Borer have been inspected. Confirmed infested trees have been removed and those residents have the option of replacing their parkway tree through the 50/50 program. A re-inspection of Ash trees will take place again in June of 2010.

DEAD/DYING TREES IN THE PARKWAY: If you have a dead or dying tree in your parkway, please call the Huntley Tree Hotline at 847-515-5223 and leave your name, address, and subdivision and our staff will inspect your tree. Inspections will now take place in June 2010 and once completed you will receive, via US Mail, information regarding the 50/50 program.

THE 2010 50/50 TREE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM: Properties that qualify for the 50/50 Parkway Tree Replacement Program will receive an order form with the choices of trees for planting. This information will be sent out in late July. Orders will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis until the budgeted funds are expended.
