Saturday is filled with events for all ages. We are inviting all children ages 2 – 12yrs old to participate in this year's Kid's Parade. Kids that wish to participate will need to be at the park by 9am to have time to prepare parade decorations. We will kick off the event at 10am with a Kid's parade lead by the Huntley High School band and Lollypop the Clown. Like last year, we will offer a Kids' area with games, a petting zoo and pony rides. The Craft and Home Business show will feature more than 35 vendors.
