HUNTLEY - Beginning Friday, November 14, 2008, Special Census enumerators will begin contacting Huntley residents at their homes to conduct interviews. Residents are urged to cooperate when census enumerators begin knocking on doors. The enumerators will ask 5 questions for each person living in a household, and the interview should take about 7 minutes. The count will be conducted during the hours of 10:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. - Monday through Saturday and 12:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. All interviewers have passed background checks and are required to display Census Bureau identification badges.

Answers are private. Every Census Bureau worker takes an oath to protect the privacy of residents. The Census Bureau never releases information that identifies residents or their households.

Participation will allow the Village of Huntley to obtain an updated population count. This new count will help Huntley qualify for federal and state revenue that is necessary to provide essential services as well as holding the line on property tax bills.
