**Re: Village Of Huntley Continues Opposition To ComEd Power Line Route**

**Information**

The Village of Huntley recently received confirmation of the administrative law judge's initial recommendation to approve ComEd's preferred route for a new 138,000 volt electric transmission line through the Village. After the parties have an opportunity to comment on that recommendation, the Illinois Commerce Commission will review the recommendation the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the project. Mayor Charles Sass stated "We are deeply disappointed by this direction and will continue to pursue all avenues available to reverse or reject this recommendation. We are committed to providing the additional resources necessary to protect the quality of life of the residents of our community."
